Thrasher generated a detailed proposal to address the basement moisture issues as described by the Kristin reports she was genuinely impressed with family. In addition, Thrasher discussed with Kristin concerns regarding the two large dirt crawlspaces cised with newly installed drywall near the stairbeneath the home on the south and east.

SOLUTION:

In February 2011, after a facelift to much of the home's interior finishes and a successful estate sale, the Peterson's hired Thrasher Basement Systems to install 112 feet of interior sub-floor drainage, a single sump pump system and an ice guard fitting for the exterior buried discharge line.

With the interior waterproofing system in place, the Peterson family listed the home with HOME Real Estate's, Steve Thelen and was pleased when two purchase offers were received the first week.

The potential buyers performed a radon test and the Peterson home tested at 9.9 Pci/L - above the EPA action level of 4.0 Pci/L. Kristin contacted Thrasher for a radon mitigation system estimate and to address concerns regarding both crawlspaces.

Thrasher Basement Systems installed a total of 672 square feet of 20 mil Cleanspace Encapsulation Liner and dimpled drainage matting in both crawlspaces and established suction points below both for the radon system. Before encapsulation of the crawlspaces, Thrasher removed the existing
